# What Kind of Cozy Stay Do You Need?

This short guide helps you figure out what type of cozy basecamp fits your trip - so you don't overlook, overpay, or end up somewhere that doesn't match your adventure style.

Grab a pen, or read along and notice what resonates.

## Step 1: What Season Are You Traveling?

- Winter (snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, frozen lakes)
- Spring Shoulder Season (quiet trails, mixed conditions)
- Summer (hiking, paddling, backpacking)
- Fall (larches, cool morning, early nights)



## Step 2: What's the Main Reason for this Trip?

Choose the one that matters most.

- Big adventure days (long hikes, ski days, paddling)
- Slower exploration days (walks, viewpoints, short trails)
- Recovery-focused (hot springs, rest, reset)
- A mix of adventure + downtime



## Step 3: What Do You Want Your Evenings to Feel Like?

This matters more than people think.

- Fireplace, quiet, early nights
- Walkable town, food nearby
- Remote + unplugged
- Cozy but social (lodge-style)



## Your Cozy Basecamp Style (Circle One)

### Cabin

- 🌲 Best for: winter trips, quiet vibes & shoulder seasons
- 🌲 Ideal if you want: privacy, fireplaces, slower mornings

### Lodge

- 🌲 Best for: winter trips, social trips, easy access to adventures
- 🌲 Ideal if you want: cozy common spaces without full isolation

### Hotel

- 🌲 Best for: walkable towns, short stays, mixed itineraries
- 🌲 Ideal if you want: meal convenience, comfort after adventure days



# What “Cozy” Actually Means After an Adventure Day

Cozy isn't about luxury. It's about how a place feels when you come back tired, cold or sunburned from the mountains.

Here's what matters most for outdoor enthusiasts.

## 1. Proximity Beats Perfection

A slightly imperfect stay close to trails, lakes, or ski areas almost always feels better than a perfect one that adds long drives. Less time commuting = more energy for the adventure (and the couch).

## 2. Warmth, Quiet & Recovery Matter

After a big day outside, cozy looks like:

- space to dry gear
- warm lighting
- quiet mornings
- comfortable seating
- somewhere you want to stay in the evening



## 3. Different Trips Need Different Stays

The stay you want for:

- a winter weekend
- a shoulder season reset
- a summer hiking basecamp

Choosing based on the experience you want changes everything.



## Common Booking Mistakes Outdoor Travelers Make

- Booking for aesthetics instead of location
- Ignoring seasonal conditions
- Overpaying for features they won't use
- Underestimating how tired they'll be at night
